

GERMAN ROACH TREATMENT PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

Pathfinder pest control

For best results follow these instructions, they are only recommendations not requirements. These instructions only applied for the FIRST treatment.

Please make sure no children are in the treatment area.

Put up all pets or remove them from the treatment area. This usually means putting the dog outside and putting the cat in a crate.

The presence of children and pets can affect how well we treat the property.

No cooking or preparing food before or during treatment. Leave No exposed food on the counter like fruit, cooking oil or spices.

Remove ALL items from kitchen cabinets, food, dishes, pots & pans. Remove everything. Place items on the kitchen table or place them in a different room. Do not place items on the kitchen counters, we will treat the counter as well.

Remove any items on top of the refrigerator and stove. Put away any food that begins defrosted into the refrigerator.

Leave appliances like microwaves, blenders or coffee machines on the counter.

Ensure your house is well-lit to help us properly inspect and treat your home effectively. Darkness can provide roaches more time to discover shelter and food sources..

Be sure that your technician has free and full access to the entire home..When treating German roaches we would recommend treating the complete house. Sometimes roaches can scatter to the kitchen and bathroom to survive in other rooms of the home.

AFTER TREATMENT

Following these instructions after a professional is crucial to removing roaches from home forever.

Airing out the home or area after treatment is not necessary; this could negatively affect the treatment. You can place items back into the cabinets, once the cabinets are completely dry. Use this time to throw away any unwanted items, and seal up food before placing back in the cabinets. **Pro tip** : Seal up pasta and cereal boxes and place flour and sugar bags in a ziplock bag. Emptying the kitchen and bathroom trash nightly, this will help eliminate a food source for roaches. Stop eating in your bedroom until the roaches are contained to the kitchen area. Seal up dog & cat food bags every night, and dont leave pet dishes out overnight. Keep the house well-lit during the day this will eliminate a lot of hiding places for the roaches. Cleaning Kitchen daily .Do not leave dirty dishes in the sink nightly.

For Extreme infestations : Dry out kitchen and bathroom sinks with a bleach or alcohol solution. Plug drains at night. Seal up sponges and dishcloths.
