

FLEA TREATMENT PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

For best results please follow preparation instructions.

Important: all dogs and cats must be medically treated for fleas and ticks before service. Wash and dry your pet bedding and toys. And Remove water and food bowls.

Before appointment, vacuum all flooring in the home including carpet, tile, hardwood and vinyl flooring. Keep the vacuum outside or in the garage and empty the canister after every use.

Keep vacuum handy in case a technician needs to use it as well.

Do not prepare food or have food out on countertops before treatment.

Make sure the technician is able to move around all furniture such as couches, recliners and chairs. Be able to exit the property after treatment for up to 2 hours.

Make sure all items are off the couches.

Entire home must be treated for fleas. This will help with any fleas trying to run into other rooms to survive. For exterior treatments make sure no toys are in the yard.

Also treating the exterior combined with the interior property will provide a more comprehensive treatment.

AFTER TREATMENT

Unoccupied properties must be vacuumed everyday. **7 - 14 days** after treatment.

Vacuum all flooring in the home including carpet, tile, hardwood, vinyl flooring every 24 hours. **5-7 days after treatment.**

The property does not need to be aired out after treatment.

Wash and dryer all bedding and pillows.

Mowing the lawn: If the yard is being treated, mow the grass.
